Dear Food Establishment Operator/Owner-

This is the third letter sent to you on the topic of the new **FDA Model Food Code.** Please recall from our first August 23, 2017 letter that Connecticut's food code will be undergoing a significant transformation. This new law will result in a variety of changes for the food establishments in CT and the local health departments that regulate them. This letter is being sent to notify you of an important change to the previously detailed timeline for compliance with the new code. Specifically, *Public Act 18-168 extends the date for adoption of the FDA Food Code to "not later than January 1, 2019"*.

How does this affect your food service operation? The simple answer is that the code changes that were scheduled to go into effect on July 1, 2018 are now delayed. Because of the specific language in the public act cited above all we can tell you now is that the delay cannot go past January 1, 2019.

As soon as we are notified of the specific date that these code changes go into effect, we will notify you immediately. In the meantime, we encourage you to review information currently available in preparation for this important transition. For more information go to: www.ehhd.org/fdacodes
