Qualified Food Operator

For Class III and IV Establishments

- On Site & Full Time
- In a Supervisory Position
- Authority to Direct and Inspect the Performance of Food Service Workers
- Completed an Approved Safe Food Handling Course
- Responsible for:
 - Ensuring TRAINING of Food Preparation Personnel
 - Maintaining Documentation of a TRAINING PROGRAM and TRAINING RECORDS
 - OPERATING in COMPLIANCE with the Public Health Code Sect. 19-13-B42

Designated Alternate

- In Charge When the QFO Cannot be Present
- Has the Same Knowledge as the QFO
- Has the Same Authority in the Absence of the QFO

Replacement of a QFO

- When QFO Terminates or Transfers, Notify EHHD in Writing
- Must be Replaced within 60 days of Date of Termination or Transfer

A Qualified Food Operator or Designated Alternate Is Required On-Site During All Hours of Operation
