ASTHMA TRIGGERS

Asthma attacks can be caused by something that bothers the lungs. This is called an *asthma trigger*. There are many kinds of asthma triggers.

Americans spend up to 90% of their time indoors. Contact with indoor allergens and irritants may play an important role in triggering asthma episodes.

The most common indoor environmental asthma triggers are:

Smoking, including second hand smoke

Cockroaches

Dust mites

Mold and Mildew

Pets and other animals with fur or feathers

It is important to learn which triggers are a problem for your child. Once asthma triggers are known, you can take action to prevent asthma attacks.

WHO WILL CHECK MY HOME FOR ASTHMA TRIGGERS?

A health professional and an environmental health specialist will visit your home. They'll go over their findings with you and make suggestions to help you control your child's asthma. Most of the suggestions are simple and practical.

You can take part in *Putting on AIRS* if a doctor has said that your child has asthma.
